Retiree Repeater NET Script (Wednesday Mornings)

Calling all radio amateurs, calling all radio amateurs:

This is the weekly Retiree Net of the Amateur Radio Transmitting Society of Louisville; also known as ARTS. This net meets on the W4CN Repeater, 147.180 Mhz. Note you will need a PL Tone of 79.7 Hz to open the repeater squelch; again, that's a PL Tone of 79.7 Hz. We meet each Wednesday morning at 9:00 AM local time.

All amateurs are welcome to participate in this net. You do not need to be a retiree to participate.

This is **(your call sign)**, your net control operator, and my name is **(your name)**.

The purpose of this net is primarily for amateurs to get to know one another better. We do this by welcoming announcements of upcoming events, by allowing participants to list equipment they want to buy, sell, or trade, and by providing a forum for the exchange of information. All amateurs are welcome to check in with us.

Before we begin, the next ARTS Club meeting will be held on Thursday, **(2nd Thursday of the month, give date)**, at 7:30 PM at the Jeffersontown Fire Station Two, formerly known as the McMahan Fire Department, 4318 Taylorsville Road. There is ample, secure parking behind the building. Everyone is welcome to attend and an interesting program is planned for each meeting.

1. At this time are there any announcements for the good of the group?

- (Remind everyone about our repeater nets and 2 meter SSB nets on Thursdays: Repeater at 8:30; and Upper Side Band at 9:05 on 144.205 Mhz.
- Remind people of any upcoming events like field day events, gift exchange, next club meeting program if known, annual dinner meeting etc.)

(When taking check in information, do not quick-key, allow more than one person to check in when you call a range of call signs.)

2. Does anyone have any equipment they would like to buy, sell, or trade?
3. We'll begin taking check-ins. First, are there any mobile stations? If so, please check-in now. Give me your call sign slowly and phonetically, and your first name. (Ask for comments from mobile stations now before going on, in case they drive out of range etc.)
4. Are there any portable stations/HTs? If so, please check-in now. Give me your call sign slowly and phonetically, and your first name. (Ask for comments from portable stations now before going on, in case they move out of range, battery dies etc.)
5. Thirdly are there any Echolink stations that would like to check into the ARTS Club net? If so, please check-in now. Call **(call sign of net control operator)**. (Be sure to pause a while here as Echolink has a delay between receive and transmit.)
6. We'll now take fixed stations. Check-ins will be taken according to the first letter of your call sign suffix. Give me your call sign slowly and phonetically, and your first name. We'll begin with stations:

(Call by groups:

- **Alpha - Kilowatt**
- **Lima - Zulu**
- **now any station Alpha – Zulu)**.

(Go back to the top of your check-in list for Echolink and Fixed Stations and begin taking comments from each station.)

(At end of list, ask for any more check-ins Alpha thru Zulu. After going through

your list ask once more for comments before closing the net.)

This is **(Your Call Sign)** thanking you for checking in with us this morning and invite you to return again next Wednesday at 9:00 AM and to join our Repeater and 2 Meter SSB nets on Thursdays.

This is **(Your Call Sign)**, CLEAR.
